Homework

This section I had in my previous newsletter but it is still of the highest importance to help your children as much as possible at home and it is always very much appreciated.

As per our school Homework Policy children will be expected to spend up to 1 hour on homework tasks, this can include:

- Reading books and key words
- Learning spellings
- Learning number facts
- English activities
- Maths activities

It is important to encourage and assist your child with their reading and spellings at home as we have seen the fantastic impact this has on their essential skills for learning. Please can you also practice the words at the front their reading diaries when reading. We aim to change reading books every Tuesday and Thursday. Your child will need to have their book bags in school daily please. Every Friday your child will be given a home spelling book, these spellings need to be learnt and your child needs to use these within a sentence

to demonstrate understanding. Spelling books need to be returned every Thursday. If this is not completed unfortunately your child will have to complete it in their golden time as they will be falling behind if it is not completed.

PE lessons are timetables for Wednesday and Thursday every week so please ensure your child has a full kit in school. Kits will be left in school and returned home at the end of every half term.
