

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back after the summer break! We have a few reminders for you and an update of what we will be learning this term.

This term we will be learning all about Ancient Greece. We will be exploring all different aspects of the Ancient Greek life, including looking at what life was like in those times and comparing it with our lives now.

This will link to our first Art topic this year which is creating Greek pots. The children will have the opportunity to work with clay to create their own and will eventually be able to bring it home to share with you. We will then move on to looking at the artist Picasso and will be creating our own work using his style.

In Science this half term we will be learning about geology, mixtures and separation. We start with exploring mixtures and separation with lots of different exciting demonstrations and experiments. We will then be focusing more on geology, investigating different rocks and their features.

#### General Reminders

Your child should be changing their reading book when they have finished reading it and there is evidence in their diary that they have read at home. Reading should be completed daily along with spellings and times table practise. There will soon be a times table booklet that your child will bring home on a daily basis to complete. The children are currently being shown how to use the booklet before they are able to bring it home to complete.

Water bottles should be provided from home with your child's name on it.
