Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to your child's final year at Bells Farm Primary.

The children have made a fantastic start to the year and are already demonstrating the brilliant work that they are capable of – a very positive sign for the year ahead.

In Year 6, the children benefit from an improved teacher: child ratio, with Maths lessons being taught by Mr Johnston, Miss McClelland and Mrs Butterworth and English lessons being taught by Mr Johnston and Miss McClelland.
