This is in the interests of safeguarding. Please ensure that you keep us updated with any change of contact details. Many thanks.

Please ensure that all monies are given to the office in a sealed envelope with your child's details on the front. Can you please make sure that dinner monies are paid on a Monday morning **every week** (£10.25 per week) for your child.

As clubs have started now, please ensure you collect your child on time.

PE Kit

Just in case you are doing some early shopping for September, we have made the decision to keep the future PE kit very simple. For new or replacement kits, a plain white t-shirt, blue or black shorts and black pumps should be worn. We do not expect you to replace the present house colour kit until your child is ready for a new one.


