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### **Bells Farm Primary School Sports Premium 2014 - 2015**

The Government is providing funding of 150 million per annum for academic years 2013/14 and 2014/15 to provide quality primary PE and school sport. Each school will receive £7535 plus an additional £5 per pupil for the next two years – for Bells Farm Primary this will equate to approximately £9,000

#### **Provision in School**

As a school we already provide high quality Physical Education and sport, and our intention is that this funding will further enhance the existing provision in school.

- All children benefit regardless of sporting ability;
- All children have the opportunity to compete in competitions at some level;

#### **Governors agree that the funding must be used so that:**

- For children to work towards and achieve differing levels of Core Proficiency in gymnastics via the BGA awards scheme;
- The most able children are given the opportunity to participate in inter-school competitions;
- Staff have access to training opportunities and continued professional development.

#### **Our funding in 2014-15 will be used in the following way:**

- To join the Baverstock Schools Partnership in order to develop sporting skills, access services and compete in Inter-school competitions. The services will include training for teachers through courses provided by Bishop Challoner Secondary School;
- To contribute towards a qualified PE teacher - to develop physical education skills with our children, provide assessments of their abilities and provide professional development for our teaching staff through modelling of good practice and support for planning;
- To provide release time for teachers to access training and observations of good practice;
- To contribute towards the employment of a sports teacher to teach sport skills to our children through lunch time and after school clubs.

#### **Reporting outcomes**

Updates relating to our provision for PE and sport will be provided throughout the school year through the school website and newsletters. The impact of the funding will also be reported annually to parents and governors.

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
